Club Ride 2014

The weather finally allowed the Club Ride to be held on Saturday, February 15. Snowfall the two preceding days made sure all trails had plenty of the white stuff.

Rally points included the Hillview Inn, Esperance, and Jonathan's in Duaneburg. Hot coca and donuts were served at the Hillview.

Meanwhile grooming crews were out hitting the trails early Saturday morning. However all attempts to groom the heavy snow failed. Too much snow had fallen on Friday and no one had ridden very far on the trails to break them open. This meant most snowmobiles would not be able to get through the deep snow.

The grooming drags were cutting the snow fine, but were unable to break trail at the same time. The groomer team out of Delanson, Rich Valletta and Joel Church decided instead of grooming they would have to break open the trails with the Skandics. The Super Wide Track Skandics were able to plow through the deep snow and climb the drifted hills.

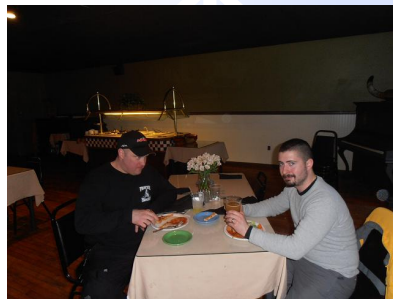
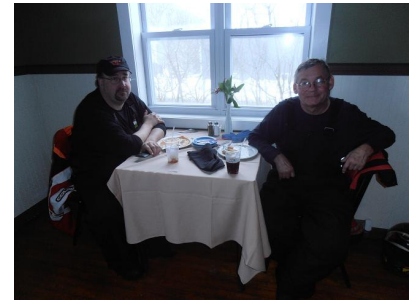
Riders began arriving at the Maple Inn between 3 and 4pm. Pizza, sausage and peppers, Swedish meatballs, and more awaited the riders.

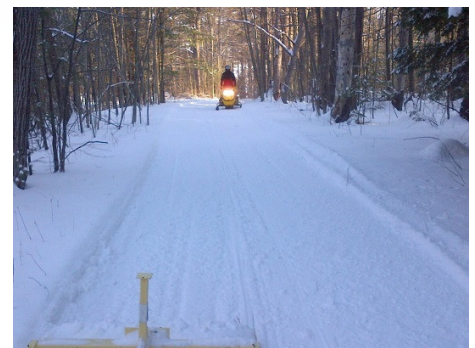

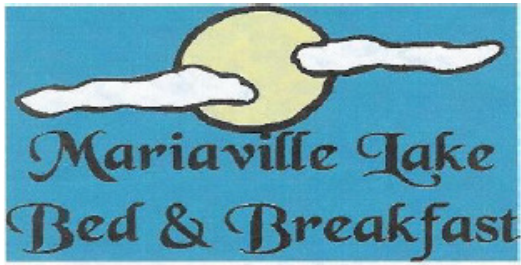

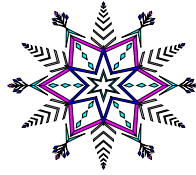
