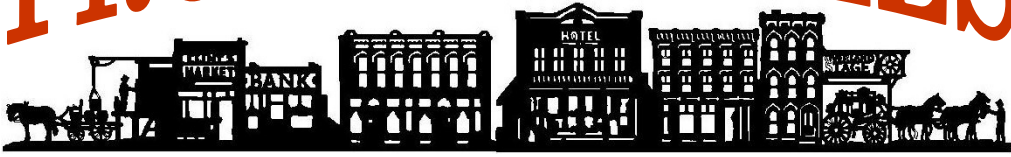
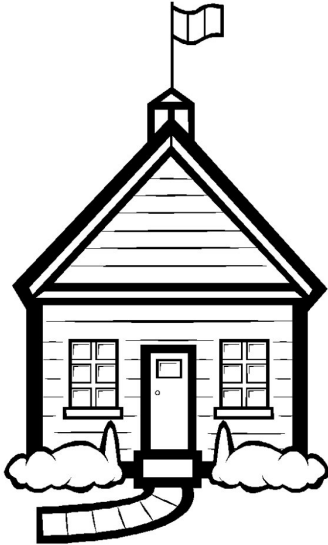

Others are going into storage. Rich Gobel volunteering to build club a drag. Skandic 03' currently the oldest in fleet, still a good runner. New drag build cost \$1000.

**Knox C7B** - Open - Softball bridge needs new deck, may be good location for the Carver frame there.

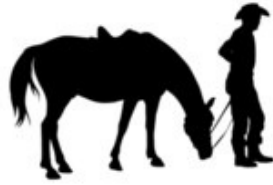
**Maple Inn S73** - Donnie Bauer - Gates are closed, signs to be pulled yet.

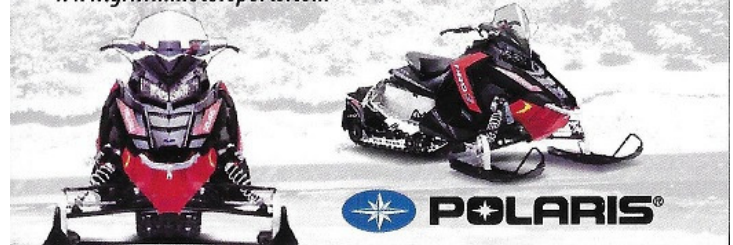
