

Western Gateway - Sloansville

For those looking to explore regions to the west of the Frontier trails, finding the way to Sloansville is key.

There is a network of local trails spreading out from the village. Some going back to the early 70's. Over the years trails had been established going off towards the Charleston State Forest, Schoharie, Carlisle, and Charleston 4-Corners by Trail Boss Laudy Hoyenga and his local friends.

The last few years he has developed trails with the Cave Country Riders and now with our Frontier club. Currently Laudy and his local friends still maintain some local trails going west with several bridges on them.

C7F is a major east/west trail which passes through Sloansville.

The trail keeps close to US Rt 20, crossing it numerous times as it visits places like Carlisle, Sharon, Sharon Springs and Cherry Valley.

Unfortunately you will not be able to see a couple of historic sites near the trails, that of the Sloan family grave sites or the Indian stone heap on Sloansville Hill next to Route 30A.

One of the best views near here is on top of Terrace Mountain on the trail going off towards Summit, at night it is an awesome site looking down on Central Bridge. Nearby Esperance has more history and of course the Arboretum.

Trail Log

East Berne - Brian Buchardt - A new trail has been cut to the Maple Inn on Warner's Lake. This will allow riders to avoid having to cross the Lake.

Knox + Wright - Ron Shultes - On the roped off field south of Westfall Rd, C7B now runs straight across the field instead of the field edge. Watch for a new culvert half way across the field. The woods east of Blue Huron Airport have been widened and smoothed out.

Sloansville - Laudy Hoyenga - Trails and equipment and ready for snow.

Duanesburg/Delanson - Rich Valletta - C7B has been widened and smoothed just north of Schoharie Tpk. Some hilly areas were removed.

Burtonsville - John Scrima - No report.

Mariaville - Jerry Schoening - C7B has been cleared from Batter St. to Merry Rd. A huge thank you goes out to John Cislo from CT who spent 5 hours cutting up and clearing fallen trees from Batter St to Mariaville Peat. He did all this on his own volition without any help. This was a major job as the woods on Elmer Hewitt's property were a total mess from the heavy snowfall we rec'd up here. Matt Harper and I cleaned the trail from my place to Merry Road and then signs were put in place from my place to Mariaville Peat. Tom Rulison informed me that he and his brother installed a reroute to eliminate the steep hill in his brother's woods. This has yet to be signed and the new route has ribbons to show the way and signs will be put in place soon.

Esperance - Tom Rulison - The New Holland groomer is now going to be working this area on C7E.







Club Makes Huge Push To Sign

Early snowfalls put some of the sign posting projects behind schedule. Add to that a recent trail inspection by NYSSA, field staking was found to be wanting in many areas.

Field staking are guide posts set in pairs on long field stretches where snowmobilers could lose their way if no previous tracks have been made. This is likely to occur if a large amount of snow falls.

Three staking posts are used on blind hills so that snowmobilers can stay right of oncoming traffic.

Frontier trail bosses have been out in force since the 1st of the year adding sign posts where needed.


