The OnX app will be purchased for the trail bosses to use while out on the trail. This app shows in realtime whose property the user is on. It displays property lines and the snowmobile trails.

The Skandic fleet is up and running, some of the drags are still apart waiting for repair and painting.

The PB70 needs an oil change and the water pump replaced.

The PB100 will keep the 16' drag this season while the club tries to locate a 14' to replace it.

A CPR/First Aid class is being looked into so that members can work with chainsaws on the stateland.

Dec 19th marks first day club trails could open, snow conditions allowing of course.

All trail boss remember, you have a 60 day window in which to submit your work logs to Christine Rulison, club grants writer.

Club will soon have a credit card again as Gerry Lenseth has agreed to act as primary card holder.

Potter's in Mariaville may be a suitable site for use as club house. Club is looking into this.

A stump grinder will be available for use on the club trails, trail boss please identify where on your trails need stumps ground.

30% grant funds have come in from Albany and Schenectady Counties, still waiting for Montgomery and Schoharie.

Mileage has been restored to the full 3 miles on C7B in Montgomery County for funding this year.

Sawyer Cresap of the Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy which owns the Winn Preserve, where S70 runs, is working with Trail Boss Skip Murrell to curb illegal ATV activity. Real erosion damage near Street Road is occurring.





Northern Area

Burtonsville/Charleston C7E - John Scrima -Bridge on Irish Creek is finished and ready for sleds.

Mariaville C7B - Mark VanWoeart - 80% complete with Lake Rd connection reroute. Most signs are up. Bush hogging not yet started.

Sloansville C7F - Laudy Hoyenga - New bridge installed on out-law trail to the Stockyard.



Central Area

Esperance/Delanson C7E - Tom Rulison - Snow fencing and signage were recently installed next to the Duanesburg Elementary School. ATVs causing trail damage behind Esperance Auto.

Duanesburg C7B - Dominick Friello - Conditions remain very wet, limiting trail work. With the cold moving in now, the ground is beginning to freeze.

Wright C7B - Joel Church - Signs are going up and trail brushing continues. A reroute is being sought near Benninger Road trail closure. Closure due to snowmobiles riding off trail.

Knox C7B - Orvil Bates - S71, trail to the Highlands is closed due to property up for sale. C7B is still open.

East Berne C7B/S72 - Brian Buchardt– Signs are mostly up.




