Two storms dumped tempting snowfalls after some gates closed and signs were pulled. In both cases the ground was not frozen and the snow began melting right away.



All grooming machines will require summer storage preparation. Recommended that all tracks be removed, palletized and stored out of the elements.

ATV and UTV's should have wheels installed and utilized in the off season.

Drags should be stored off the ground and actuators and hoses protected from the elements.

Price Chopper has offered a choice of current retired box trailers for ~\$1K each. One trailer will provide adequate storage for six Skandics plus additional club equipment for offseason storage. Location tbd. Discussion for pending motion to be opened at next meeting.

Jeep, UTV and ATV club equipment will be stored at respective trail boss areas as well as drags. PB070 can be stored at Gerry L's storage shed. PB100 will be stored at Karl P's toy barn.

Club drags should be supported off the ground and track units should be removed and stored out of direct sunlight.


