C7F and Stockyard trail (#456) landowners received a special note with the annual letter informing them of Laudy's retirement from Trail Boss and notification of new contacts.

Schoharie County 70% grant check will be reduced from \$5,553 to \$2,000 due to lack of trail maintenance work logs and low grooming anticipated from current trail closure. Additional funds will be released in late winter if work logs and grooming logs increase.

Continued from page 1 provided his years of trail signing experience in marking the trail according to NYS Parks parameters and landowner requests. Please be sure to observe all sign instructions and stay on the marked trail and respect the private property that you will traverse.

This trail meanders for 3.4 miles through beautiful wooded sections and out through active farming fields – always ride to the marked perimeter of the field as indicated by sign posts unless otherwise marked. A small portion of the trail will require road edge riding along Helderberg Trail (Rt 443) to cross over the Fox Creek and we caution all snowmobilers to proceed carefully observing vehicle traffic approaching the establishment. Snowmobile parking is available on the eastern side of Rt 443 at the lower lot/ pagoda area between the creek and the restaurant.
