



# **Thacher Park Vintage Ride 2024**

#### **Club Members Encouraged To Come Out**

Frontier Sno-Riders will host our first Vintage Snowmobile Rally event at John Boyd Thacher State Park on Sunday, March 17<sup>th</sup> from 10am to 3pm near East Berne on Rt 157.

The event will operate Snow or Shine – plan to enjoy a day at the Park with fellow vintage enthusiasts regardless of the weather. Bring out all your vintage sleds to display and operate if ample snow exists at Thacher Park. It only takes a few inches to enjoy the old sleds on the Park trails.

Frontier has secured the required permits with both Thacher Park and the OPRHP snowmobile unit. Club volunteers will administer the event centralized out of the Pear Orchard parking area near the Visitors Center utilizing the existing marked and groomed snowmobile trails within the Park (as indicated on the page 8 map).

With over six miles of trails to traverse from the Frontier kiosk on S72 near Beaver Dam Rd to the Park accesses at Carrick Rd and Old Stage Rd – the Park offers an ideal venue for vintage enthusiasts to operate their old snowmobiles while giving the general public a chance to take pictures and interact with riders. Please note that snowmobile registration and insurance is required beyond the Park on S72.

The special event will allow vintage

enthusiasts an opportunity to operate a variety of 1960's to early 1990's snowmobiles within the Park confines without requiring DMV registrations unless operated beyond the Park boundary on Frontier trail S72. Frontier encourages participants to obtain snowmobile insurance coverage for your vintage sleds however participants ride at their own risk for this special event.

OPRHP requires that this is a Zero Tolerance alcohol event and slow speeds are required throughout the Park – with law enforcement presence on patrol and first responders on call. Frontier will groom for the event and club volunteers will operate Skandic snowmobiles with communication to respond and assist with stranded snowmobiles and support as needed.
