Albany BOCES has requested Frontier provide a scholarship application for the students to apply for the three individual \$250 Frontier Scholarships for the work completed on the PB100. Chad and club educators have been requested to draft, submit and review the scholarship application process with Nancy Liddle at BOCES.

NYSSA raffle tickets are available for distribution to club members for fundraising - see Tammy Saddlemire.

Pres. Gerry Lenseth to open a discussion with Board of Trustees regarding club By Laws spending limits. Several items to be addressed including current requirement for \$500+ expenditures requiring Board approval - specifically pertaining to Officer of the organization. Recommending an increase to \$1,000 for Officer approved expenditures. Meal expense needs to be revisited with spike in retail food cost and tip expectations.

Burtonsville/Charleston C7E - Yancey Zimmer -Northern section near Mill Point signed. Mariaville C7B - Mark VanWoeart - Bridge steel is staged for gusseting. Existing bridge will require excavator for removal and i-beam install. Project postponed till postseason. Work between Lake Rd and Mary Rd entering the Florida trail system. Brushing, signing and widening trails.

Sloansville C7F - Chris Teahen - Reroute crossing Rt 30A and approach to Sloansville Mobil.

Central Area

Esperance/Delanson C7E - Tyler Walters - Ready for snow and riding!

Duanesburg C7B/S70 - Rob Kreitzer - Rob and crew signed to Rt 146. Elementary school needs to be roped off and signing required on Blessing property.

Wright C7B - X- Seeking trail boss - Matt L has drafted a proposed reroute for C7B that would require numerous landowners to provide approval. Danny P is reviewing local options and landowners will be approached to discuss proposal.

Southern Area

Township S70 - Skip Murrell - Completed recent reroute on Scrima property and signed trail. **Knox C7B** - Barak Strock - Barak S, Zack S, Skip M and Justin B signed from Knox ball field to Gaige farm. Working on reroute between Knox ball field and town park to alleviate congestion. Signs installed in Knox Park to inform riders NOT to cross foot bridges - use culvert crossing only. Babbling Brook informational sign to be installed at junction of C7B and #465.

Warner Lake S73 - Don Bauer -

East Berne C7B/S72 - Brian Buchardt - No response from two landowners for routing off of Long Rd. Kiosk needs to be located at junction on Cole Hill flats.

Thacher Park S72 - Matt Lord - Section requires a 10' replacement bridge to replace temporary pallets.



PB100 had Knox crew install tracks for seasonal operation. New wiper arms from Mohawk Industrial, Weatherguard aluminum diamond plated storage box and track adjustment tool were ordered and installed. Additional rear wiper arm ordered. Rear hydraulics were relocated and installed with proper bulkhead fittings for improved functionality. Rear snow flaps were fabricated and installed at no cost.

PB070 had several replacement items ordered from Mohawk Industrial. Rear hydraulic fittings were updated with proper fittings and orientation. Rear snow flaps have been fabricated and need to be installed at no cost.

1998 Jeep - Tyler installed auxiliary lighting and needs to replace the towing receiver for the drag.

2012 JD Gator front tracks received from Randall Implements and installed by Mark V. Rear drivers side track (replaced 2 years ago) has signs of interior surface rubber separation - contacting Mattracks directly regarding warranty coverage. Mark V recommends board consider complete track system replacement to Camso in off season and sell Mattracks.

CanAm required new airbox from rodent infestation. Gerry Lenseth installed screening to prevent future issues.

Matt Lord installed three new batteries in both '18 sleds and '13. Both '18's required brake cylinder to be drained and fluid replaced. New skags will be installed on '08 and blown headlight issue needs to be traced for fault. '06 prepped. Miscellaneous maintenance parts ordered and installed.

CanAm, three Skandics and one drag delivered for staging.

Storage trailer works well for small equipment.

Gerry Lenseth met with landowner John Cochran to obtain approval to utilize inside PB070 groomer staging along S72. Frontier will pay a nominal fee to facilitate select operator access for groomer. Invoice will be obtained to apply toward Albany county grant funding.

Frontier ordered 551 trail marking signs from Voss Signs at \$1,072.75 as requested from trail bosses. Signs have been distributed for posting. Club expense will be applied to individual county grant funding.

Special thanks to Matt Lord for assisting in small groomer fleet prep and delivery. Appreciate all trail bosses taking responsibility for maintenance and minor repairs of grooming fleet.

Small fire on the 2006 Scandic wiped out the AC power wiring harness for headlights and taillights. New wires spliced in and electric is repaired. Some seals in gearbox took damage and will need to be repaired. Ice in the Brake caliper is the likely culprit and will be addressed.


Respect our landowners who graciously provide you with the opportunity to ride your sleds on their property!















